- Cut fabrics & fuse fusible fleece or SF101 according to pattern instructions

Basic Sewing Supplies:

- Sewing machine with
 - power cord and foot control
 - basic utility foot
 - Edge Joining Foot
 - Zipper Foot or Narrow Zipper Foot
 - 1/4" Foot
 - bobbin for your machine (empty or wound with the thread you will be using for your project)
- Seam ripper
- Scissor Snips or small scissors
- byAnnie Stiletto
- Quilt Select Marker or other Fabric Marking Pen
- Floriani or OESD Turn Tool
- 1 x 6" ruler, recommended
- Quilting pins or clips
- Mettler or Aurifil thread
- Cutting mat, rotary cutter, and ruler
