



Geneva Blouse Muslin Supply List

Date of Class: Friday, October 17 from 10:30 am – 5:00 pm

Please be setup and ready to begin class at the specified time.

Book/Pattern: Geneva V-Neck Blouse by Liesl & Co.

Fabric Requirements:

- 3 yards muslin fabric
- 2 yards Pattern Ease

Additional Supplies:

- Polyester or cotton thread (this is a great time to use of leftover thread)
- Pencil for tracing
- Scissors for cutting paper
- Fabric scissors: dressmaking shears recommended
- Marking pen (it does not need to be removable when making a muslin)

Prior to Class

Please bring your measurements for upper bust, full bust, waist and hip. This class works best if you make a muslin that fits YOU. However, if you sew for someone else, please bring all their measurements listed above. You just won't be able to try the muslin on to check fit.

Basic Sewing Supplies:

- Sewing machine with
 - power cord and foot control
 - Basic utility foot
 - Bobbin for your machine (empty or wound with the thread you will be using for your project)
- Seam ripper
- Scissor Snips or small scissors
- Size 80/12 universal sewing machine needle
- 1" x 6" clear ruler
- Pins

Class Policy Reminders

- Please have class supplies purchased prior to class.
- No photocopied or sharing of patterns or books will be allowed in classes due to copyright concerns.
- Cancellation Policy: We consider your enrollment to be a commitment by you to take the class and we in turn make a commitment to the instructor. No cancellations are allowed on classes. Thank you for not asking us to make exceptions.
- The Baby Lock Brilliant is available to rent for this class if you prefer not to bring your own machine. A limited number of machines are available on a first come first serve basis. Please contact us to reserve a machine prior to class. The rental fee is \$25 per session* and includes use of the machine and 14 snap on feet. In order to not take away from class time for yourself or other students, you must arrive 30 minutes before class starts to sign a rental contract and inventory the machine accessories. A staff member will also provide an overview on use of the machine at that time. At the end of class, a staff member will again complete an inventory with you. You are responsible for any missing accessories or damage to the machine. In order to ensure the machines stay in good working order, thread must be purchased from Rae-Bon Sew & Quilt Shop.

*If you decide to purchase the machine at the end of class, your rental fee can be applied to the purchase
