

Geneva Blouse Supply List

Date of Class: Friday, November 14 from 10:30 am – 5:00 pm

Please be setup and ready to begin class at the specified time.

Book/Pattern: Geneva V-Neck Blouse by Liesl & Co.

Fabric Requirements:

- Fabric as listed on the back of the pattern, according to size making. Quilting cotton or Essex linen will work great for this blouse!

Additional Supplies:

- 1 yard Moda Soft or SF101
- Seven 7/16" buttons
- Coordinating Thread – we strongly recommend HomeDec 60 weight or Mettler 50 weight

Prior to Class

You should have already fit your muslin in our Geneva Blouse muslin class. Please wash and dry your fabric. Then press and cut out your blouse pieces from your fabric and interfacing. Please bring cut out fabric pieces to class so that we are ready to sew them together. We will not be cutting fabric during class.

Basic Sewing Supplies:

- Sewing machine with
 - power cord and foot control
 - Basic utility foot
 - ZigZag Foot
 - Overcast Foot
 - Buttonhole Foot
 - Bobbin for your machine (empty or wound with the thread you will be using for your project)
- Optional: Serger with 4 cone thread for finishing seams – alternately you can use a zig zag or overcast stitch on your machine
- Seam ripper
- Scissor Snips or small scissors
- Size 80/12 universal sewing machine needle
- Sewing Gauge or 1" x 6" clear ruler
- Hand Sewing needle for sewing on buttons
- Buttonhole Cutter, recommended
- Fray Check, recommended
- Pins

Class Policy Reminders

- Please have class supplies purchased prior to class.
- No photocopied or sharing of patterns or books will be allowed in classes due to copyright concerns.
- Cancellation Policy: We consider your enrollment to be a commitment by you to take the class and we in turn make a commitment to the instructor. No cancellations are allowed on classes. Thank you for not asking us to make exceptions.
- The Baby Lock Brilliant is available to rent for this class if you prefer not to bring your own machine. A limited number of machines are available on a first come first serve basis. Please contact us to reserve a machine prior to class. The rental fee is \$25 per session* and includes use of the machine and 14 snap on feet. In order to not take away from class time for yourself or other students, you must arrive 30 minutes before class starts to sign a rental contract and inventory the machine accessories. A staff member will also provide an overview on use of the machine at that time. At the end of class, a staff member will again complete an inventory with you. You are responsible for any missing accessories or damage to the machine. In order to ensure the machines stay in good working order, thread must be purchased from Rae-Bon Sew & Quilt Shop.

*If you decide to purchase the machine at the end of class, your rental fee can be applied to the purchase
