



## Binding Basics and Beyond

### Supply List

*Please be setup and ready to begin class at the specified time.*

**Book:** Ultimate Binding and Edge Finishing Guide

#### **Supplies:**

You're just learning the technique in this class, so no need for things to match. This is a great time to pull things out of your stash.

- (3-4) 12" Square Quilt Sandwiches (cotton fabric, batting, cotton fabric)  
Lightly quilt these pieces together so you won't have any shifting when attaching the binding and trim so the edges are even. A big X is fine or some light crossweaving.  
If you bring 3 quilt sandwiches, two of your bindings will be on the same sample. Either way is fine; it's your preference.
- (1) 1 1/2" x 34" strip for faux piping
- 3/8 yard of fabric for various binding types
- Hand sewing needle (Jennifer recommends binding needles)

#### **Basic Sewing Supplies:**

- Sewing machine with
  - power cord and foot control
  - Basic utility foot
  - Bobbin for your machine (wound with the thread you will be using for your project)
- Seam ripper
- Marking Pen
- 1" x 6" Ruler (optional, but handy)
- Scissor Snips or small scissors
- Size 80/12 universal sewing machine needle
- Quilting pins
- DecoBob, Mettler or Aurifil thread
- Cutting mat, rotary cutter, and ruler (6" x 24")

You are responsible for any missing accessories or damage to the machine. In order to ensure the machines stay in good working order, thread must be purchased from Rae-Bon Sew & Quilt Shop.
